



Disability Insurance for Truck Drivers

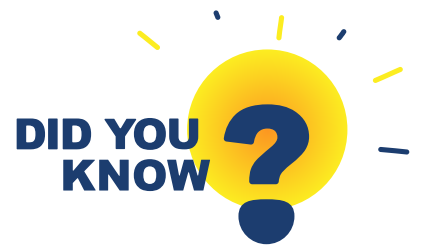

Here's How It Works
